So I didn't just assume it was better or worse. I verified it. I opened a fresh ChatGPT chat and asked which version would convert higher. It chose the rewritten version.

But I still didn't want a one-platform opinion, because that can create bias.

So to completely remove all bias, I ran the same question through Grok. Same result. It also told me the rewritten version should convert better.

I realized when two separate models, in two separate sessions, both point to the same winner, that's enough signal for me to take it seriously. Especially when the decision affects revenue.

Here's what Grok told me:

Version B would likely convert better for a WarriorPlus-style PLR product sales page, especially in 2025-2026 digital marketing trends.
